**Air Travel:** Arrangements for air travel can be made through Travelers when booking the cruise and seminar. The nearest airport to the cruise line is the Fort Lauderdale International Airport. If you make your own air travel arrangements, remember that you can board the ship at noon on Sunday (lunch provided), but you must be on board by 3:30 pm. We suggest that you do not book return flights before noon on Saturday the 11th.

*Round trip plans can be made in and out of other central Florida international airports without penalty if you wish to extend your stay. Talk with Pat at Travelers.*

**Transportation:** It is not necessary to rent a car. The airport is within minutes of the port and cab rides are under \$10.00 and far less expensive than the actual cruise ship shuttles.
